Scheduled Harvester Notice

Tuesday, June 16, 2020

Planned Harvesting: Progressive ae has engaged PLM to harvest Lake Lansing later this week.

PLM is the company that has been doing the chemical treatments for the last few years, and with the retirement of our long time harvester last year, PLM successfully bid for the work this year.

PLM as a company is very familiar with Lake Lansing, but in as much as this is their first year harvesting Lake Lansing in some time, there may be a few hiccups. Ingham County also does not have the new second harvester access site on Shaw Street completed, so the congestion at the boat ramp may be an issue for a couple days. We are working to minimize the issues.

The lake has been surveyed three times now, and the pesky milfoil is still very sparse. There is a significant but normal amount of Pond Weed, Elodea, and Starry Stonewort. The harvester will mainly deal with these plants.

We expect that the harvesting will be done sometime next week.

We will continue to monitor and advise as necessary.
