Scheduled Treatment Notice

HERBICIDE TREATMENT: Lake Lansing is scheduled to be chemically treated on Monday, August 9, 2021. The actual application date and time is subject to change because it is dependent on a number of factors including weather.

Please see attached Posting Notices and Posting Map (Dated July 20, 2021) for details and restrictions. This is the same notice that will be posted along the shoreline on the day of application.

With this treatment, there are two different posting signs. The two signs will be posted adjacent to the properties where the two separate products are being used. In addition, the signs will be posted with a map at each of the access sites around the lake due to the fact that the treatment area is greater than 2 acres.

This notice and alert has been processed for the Lake Lansing Watershed Special Assessment District Advisory Committee by Meridian Township. 


