Legg Park

The Legg Park Natural Area offers the hiker or skier a variety of habitats to experience. Follow the trails along the Red Cedar River from meadows full of wildflowers to thick bottomlands and wooded uplands.



Trail Conditions
 Some parts of these trails are located within the floodplain and may be wet, or even impassable during rainy seasons. Please do not ride bikes or horses on the trails at these times.
 The distances on the legend refer to the entire trail length. To learn the exact distance of the route you walked, stop into the Harris Nature Center, 3998 Van Atta Road.

Oxbow Trail

.75 mile trail: follow the Δ

Begin the Oxbow Trail at Van Atta Road, just across the street from the Harris Nature Center, or join it from the Songbird Trail. Much of the Oxbow Trail follows the Red Cedar River as it meanders along, eroding its bank on one side and depositing a new bank on the opposite side. During this process the river sometimes cuts off part of its own channel. This remnant is called an oxbow.

Songbird Trail

1.35 mile trail: follow the ○

The Songbird Trail begins at the picnic area where it passes through a meadow and merges with the cool woods along the river. Or begin the trail at the south end of the parking lot and wind in and out of the woods before crossing the drive to pick up the north end of the trail. As you are walking, look for songbirds darting through the meadow and singing in the woods. Follow the trail back to the picnic area or continue on to the Oak Ridge Trail.

Oak Ridge Trail

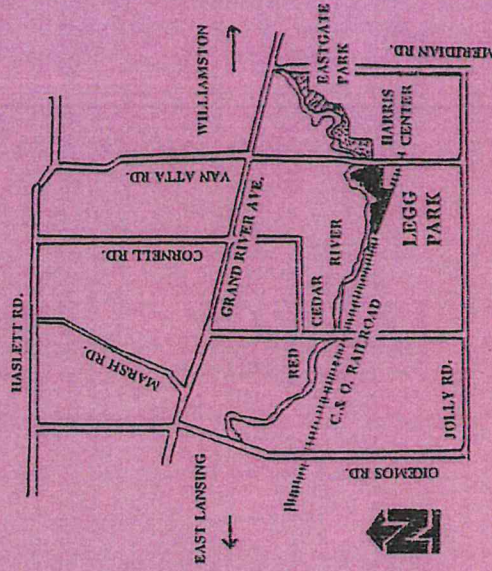
1 mile trail: follow the □

The head of the Oak Ridge Trail is near the picnic area. This wooded path follows Sloan Creek to its merge with the river. Look for Ostrich Ferns which grow in clumps, close together at the base and fanning out as the fronds reach skyward. Up on the ridge, look down at the river below and then follow the trail back through the upland forest of hickory, beech and oak trees.

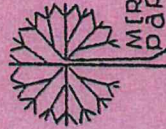

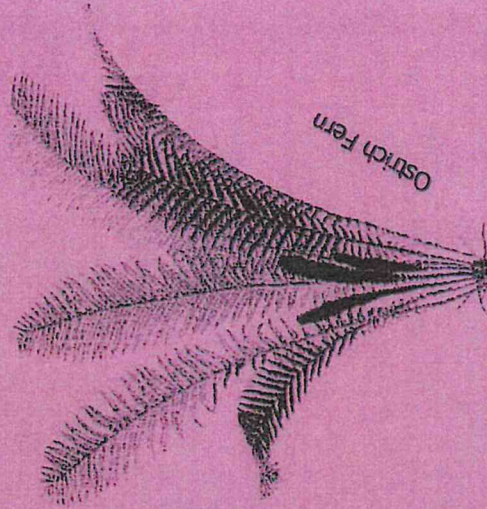

Dear Tamara,

Legg Park, located at 3891 Van Atta Road, Okemos was acquired in 1979 by Meridian Township. In 1980, The Township applied for and received a grant to assist with development costs (Project #26-01101). Two adjacent property owners have permanent easements to access their driveways through the park. Because of the odd shape of the access area, an informal trespass has existed.

The area of the trespass has been removed from the LWCF boundary map and Meridian Township was given permission to remedy the trespass with the stipulation that proceeds from the correction be invested back into Legg Park.

Items attached include:

- A letter from Sharon Edgar, Chief of Grants Administration Division detailing this information
- Copies of appraisals for parcels "A" and "B". We decided to retain parcel "C" for the time being (submitted in pdf format through email system).
- Copies of executed warrantee deeds
- Copies of checks received
- Documentation of the special account to which the funds were deposited. This will allow for a detailed documentation of expenditures in the future.

SUBJECT: 26-01101, Legg Park

I am writing in follow up to our May 30, 2002 telephone conversation regarding Legg Park. Last year the National Park Service (NPS) and Department of Natural Resources (DNR) approved the Township to remove several parcels of land adjoining the park entrance road from the 6(f) boundary of your Land and Water Conservation Fund grant. This approval allowed the Township to sell these parcels to deal with an historic, informal trespass by the adjoining residential properties.

As we have noted previously, if any of these parcels are sold the proceeds must be reinvested into Legg Park. In addition, I have additional guidance from the NPS indicating that any sale of these parcels must be done based on fair market value and based on a current appraisal. The 1997 appraisal that was reviewed and approved by the DNR is no longer considered current. The new appraisal does not require prior DNR review and approval before any sale takes place, but the Township will be required to provide the DNR with documentation that a current appraisal was done and the sale was based on fair market value. Retaining the land in Township ownership is also a route the Township may take.

By June 28, 2002, please provide me with a short, written update on the Township's plans for these parcels, i.e., sell at fair market value or retain as Township-managed land. Our mailing address is as follows:

To Whom It May Concern:

Please accept this letter as documentation that our office agrees with the content of the Section 4 (f) document and the proposed reconstruction of the canoe launch on the east side of Van Atta Road within the Harris Nature Center township-owned park property.

The original canoe launch was constructed in 1980 using Land and Water Conservation Funds and the township is required to maintain this Federally-funded amenity in perpetuity. The proposed design of the replacement bridge negatively impacts the existing canoe launch; therefore, it requires replacement in a different location. The location chosen is within the same park system, but is on the east side of Van Atta Road.

Please note that the canoe launch replacement was requested through our office on behalf of the Township and that the replacement was a condition of the Township issued Special Use Permit.

The contractor's access to the canoe launch construction area shall be limited to an area that is located from the center of the driveway to a location just west of the fire pit with a north-south orientation. All disturbed earth shall be restored to match surroundings and original grade. More detailed specifications relative to site construction may be found in the project contract documents.
