CHARTER TOWNSHIP OF MERIDIAN INITIATION OF ORDINANCE TO PROHIBIT ADULT-USE MARIHUANA ESTABLISHMENTS

Shall the Charter Township of Meridian, under the authority of Section 6, Subsection 1 of the Michigan Regulation and Taxation of Marihuana Act, Initiated Law 1 of 2018 ("MRTMA"), MCL 333.27956.1, adopt the following initiated ordinance that completely prohibits adult-use (also known as "recreational") marihuana establishments as defined in Section 3(i) of MRTMA, MCL 333.27953(i), within the boundaries of the Township: "All adult-use (also known as 'recreational') marihuana establishments as defined in Section 3(i) of the Michigan Regulation and Taxation of Marihuana Act, Initiated Law 1 of 2018, are prohibited within the boundaries of the Charter Township of Meridian." Shall the limitation on the amount of taxes which may be assessed against all property in Haslett Public Schools, Ingham, Clinton and Shiawassee Counties, Michigan, be increased by and the board of education be authorized to levy not to exceed 1.2149 mills (\$1.2149 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation) for a period of 10 years, 2023 to 2032, inclusive, to create a sinking fund for the purchase of real estate for sites for and the construction or repair of school buildings, for school security improvements, for the acquisition or upgrading of technology and all other purposes authorized by law; the estimate of the revenue the school district will collect if the millage is approved and levied in 2023 is approximately \$825,000? WHEREAS, the Township Clerk is responsible for conducting elections in the Charter Township of Meridian; and
WHEREAS, Subject to section 764d, if a city or township decides to use absent voter counting boards, the board of election commissioners of that city or township shall establish an absent voter counting board for each election day precinct in that city or township; and
WHEREAS , Subject to section 764d, the board of election commissioners shall establish the absent voter counting boards; and,
WHEREAS , Subject to section 764d, the board of election commissioners shall appoint the election inspectors to those absent voter counting boards not less than 21 days or more than 40 days before the election at which they are to be used; and,
WHEREAS , Sections 673a and 674 apply to the appointment of election inspectors to absent voter counting boards under this section. The board of election commissioners shall determine the number of ballots that may be expeditiously counted by an absent voter counting board in a reasonable period of time, taking into consideration the size and complexity of the ballot to be counted pursuant to the guidelines of the secretary of state.

WHEREAS, the Township Clerk is responsible for conducting elections in the Charter Township of Meridian; and
WHEREAS , subject to section 168.674, notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary and subject to this section, the city and township board of election commissioners, at least 21 days but not more than 40 days before each election, but in no case less than 5 days before the date set for holding schools of instruction, shall appoint for each election precinct at least 3 election inspectors and as many more as in its opinion is require for the efficient, speedy, and proper conduct of the election; and,
WHEREAS , the board of election commissioners may appoint as election inspector an individual on the lis submitted by a major political party under section 673a who is qualified to serve under section 677; and,
WHEREAS , the board of election commissioners shall designate one (1) appointed election inspector as chairperson. The board of election commissioners shall appoint at least one (1) election inspector from each majo political party and shall appoint an equal number, as nearly as possible, of election inspectors in each election precinct from each major political party.
