4. Review and Reassignment of Temporary Precinct Locations for the November 8, 2022 General Election

Clerk Guthrie reviewed the current polling locations and feedback received from election inspectors, residents and staff. The following concerns were raised on the location of Precinct 9, Church of the Nazarene, located at 1906 Hamilton Road, Okemos: one drive in and out of the site, the public area that was used for the voting area is too small to accommodate a primary election, musty smell from AC, backup on the roadway causing traffic issues, ability for emergency vehicles to enter, etc. After reviewing other possible precinct sites and in-person voting numbers, it is the recommendation of the Clerk Guthrie to relocate Precinct 9 to the Faith Lutheran Church where it will co-locate with Precincts 7 and 8. There is sufficient open public areas and parking to accommodate three (3) precincts.

Commissioner Wisinski moved to recommend to the Township Board to relocate Precinct 9 currently at the Church of the Nazarene to Faith Lutheran Church, to colocate with Precincts 7 and 8. Seconded by Commissioner Sundland

**Re:** Election Commission Action Items

The Election Commission is required to approve the establishment of an Absentee Voter Counting Board and appoint Inspectors to serve; establish a Receiving Board and appoint Inspectors to serve; and appoint Precinct Inspectors; all subject to adjustments as necessary.

The Election Commission must also schedule a public accuracy test for the November 8th, 2022 State General Election. The public accuracy test needs to be scheduled to take place no later than November 3rd. I would recommend the test be held on Friday, October 28th at 4 pm.

Also Jurisdictions with a population over 10,000 will be eligible for pre-processing. Pre-processing is allowed on the Sunday and Monday before Election Day from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. Clerks have the option to utilize one, both, or neither of the days. Election inspectors appointed by the Local Election Commission between 21 and 40 days prior to when preprocessing will start may participate in pre-processing. For the November 2022 election, this must be done by October 16 or 17, 2022, depending on when you start preprocessing. You must appoint at least one inspector from each major political party.

The following motions should be considered:

"Move to approve the resolutions of establishment of an Absentee Voter Counting Board and the appointment of Inspectors to serve; to establish a Receiving Board and the appointment of Inspectors to serve; and to appoint Precinct Inspectors to serve; and to approve the pre-processing of Absentee Ballots on November 6th and November 7th of 2022; and to appoint inspectors to serve all subject to adjustments as necessary, for the November 8, 2022 State General Election.

### RESOLUTION APPOINTING PRECINCT INSPECTORS FOR ELECTIONS HELD IN MERIDIAN TOWNSHIP

### **RESOLUTION**

At a regular meeting of the Election Commission of the Charter Township of Meridian, Ingham County, Michigan, held at the Meridian Municipal Building, in said Township on the 16th day of October, at 2:00 p.m., Local Time.

ABSENT:
The following resolution was offered by and supported by
<b>WHEREAS,</b> the Township Clerk is responsible for conducting elections in the Charter Township of Meridian; and
<b>WHEREAS</b> , subject to section 168.674, notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary and subject to this section, the city and township board of election commissioners, at least 21 days but not more than 40 days before each election, but in no case less than 5 days before the date set for holding schools of instruction, shall appoint for each election precinct at least 3 election inspectors and as many more as in its opinion is required for the efficient, speedy, and proper conduct of the election; and,
<b>WHEREAS</b> , the board of election commissioners may appoint as election inspector an individual on the list submitted by a major political party under section 673a who is qualified to serve under section 677; and,
<b>WHEREAS</b> , the board of election commissioners shall designate one (1) appointed election inspector as chairperson.
