



# Frequently Asked Questions - Speed Limits, Roads & Infrastructure

## **QUESTION:** Who sets the speed limits in the Township?

**ANSWER:** The Ingham County Road Department sets the speed limit on all public roads with the exception of the two state roads in the Township (i.e. Saginaw Hwy and Grand River Ave):
