Re: Recommendation to the Township Board for 2024 Early Voting Center Plan

If conducting an Early Voting site as a single municipality, the local legislative body must approve the Early Voting site according to MCL 168.662(1); in the same manner as polling places in section 168.662.

The Clerk's Office is recommending that one Early Voting site be located at the Meridian Township Municipal Building to serve all voters for each federal election in 2024.

MCL 168.720f (4) requires that the Early Voting Coordinator submit the early voting site to the legislative body in accordance with Section 662.

WITH THAT SAID, PA 81 of 2023, which authorized these changes to the statute, was not assigned immediate effect by the State Senate (at least not at this time) and so the act will go into effect 91 days after adjournment sine die of the legislature. So while it may be required for future years, it may not be this year. However, we recommend making a recommendation to the Meridian Township Board for the Early Voting site and Early Voting plan in 2024 as a matter of good practice and government transparency.

It is worth pointing out that the local legislative body does approve the budget, so please ensure that that component is covered by your local Council or Board so that the expenditure is authorized in whatever way is typical for your municipality.

A local legislative body may adopt a resolution to conduct early voting for local elections. We also recommend making a recommendation to the Township Board to pass a resolution of support to conduct early voting in Meridian Township in 2024. This plan must be filed with the County Clerk by Monday, October 30, 2023, in accordance with MCL 168.720e.

Early Voting Plan

No later than 120 days before the first statewide or federal election in each even numbered year, the clerk of the municipality is responsible for ensuring an Early Voting Plan is filed with the county clerk of the county in which the municipality is located.

Not less than 45 days before the first early voting day allowed by statute, the clerk will be responsible for providing the Secretary of State any changes made to a previously submitted Early Voting Plan that affect the locations, dates, and hours of operation for each early voting site operated by the municipality. This ensures that the correct information is posted on the Michigan Voter Information Center (MVIC) portion of the Department of State's website.
