Any qualified elector who is not already registered, may register to vote at the office of their local clerk; the office of their County Clerk; a Secretary of State Branch Office, or other designated state agency. Qualified electors who have a valid Michigan driver's license or state ID, may register online at <https://mvic.sos.state.mi.us/>. Registration forms may be obtained at mi.gov/vote and mailed or dropped off at the office of their local clerk. Voters who are already registered may update their registration at www.expressSOS.com.

The last day to register in any manner other than in-person with the Meridian Township Clerk's Office is April 22, 2024. After this date, anyone who qualifies as an elector must register to vote in person with proof of residency (MCL 168.492) at the following locations and times:

ABSENT VOTER BALLOTS:

Any registered voter may request an Absent Voter Ballot. No reason required.

The Clerk's Office must have a signed application to issue an Absent Voter Ballot. You may apply online at <https://mvic.sos.state.mi.us/Home/RegisterToVote> or at the Meridian Township Clerk's Office.

May 6, 2024, at 4 pm is the deadline to request an absentee ballot except for those who register to vote on Election Day.

Those registering to vote on Election Day, May 7, 2024, are eligible to receive an Absent Voter Ballot at the East Lansing City Clerk's Office, located at 410 Abbot Road, East Lansing, MI.
