175 Years of Meridian

Follow the history of the Township and discover the growth and prosperity in the community.

1836 November 1, 1836 Obed Marshall and his brother bought 160 acres of land, south of Lake Lansing, in Haslett for **\$318.08**. They were probably the first settlers in Meridian Township. 1839 In December, 1839, J.H. Kilbourne built the **first house** in Meridian Township in Okemos. 1857 The name of the post office was changed to Okemos after the desires of the people.

1842

The Township of Meridian was organized by an act of the **Legislature** approved on February 16, 1842.

1842

The first township meeting was held at the home of George Matthews. The **first sawmill** was built by Freeman Bray after he laid out the village of Okemos in 1841.

1870

One of the finest pleasure resorts in this portion of Michigan is located at the northern extremity of Pine Lake. It becomes a favorite resort for

pleasure-seekers

for many years.

1870 - 1874



1859 In 1859 the state

legislature renamed Hamilton Village to Okemos Village in honor of Chief Okemos. Born around 1775, Chief Okemos lived until 1858. Native Americans led by

Chief Okemos lived in this vicinity trading with white settlers in the area, including Freeman Bray, who founded the village of Hamilton in 1840. Chief Okemos was buried near Portland Michigan on Sacred Indian Lands.

A group of Lansing businessmen built a social club in the middle of Pine Lake, called the **Izzer Club**. (It is rumored that during prohibition, the trap door was used to hide liquor from the feds).

1888

An auditorium was dedicated at Haslett Park that could seat 2000. There was a dormitory/hotel, dining hall, Séance Hall, barn for horses, and boating facilities.



1910

1923

In 1923 **Grand River Road** became a state trunk line and was rerouted north of its original location, which was Hamilton Road. Hamilton was a plank road at this time. Some of these planks are on display at the Meridian Historical Village.

1934

The **Mayfair Bar** was established in 1934 and is known to be the oldest neighborhood bar with the longest running continuous liquor license in Ingham County.

The present building was constructed in 1928. Bret Story obtained the bar in 1996 and is still the current owner.

On September 14, 1971 a Charter of the City of Meridian Park was published. Becoming

Meridian Hills city failed at the polls. The Mayor and the city councilmen who were elected but didn't have a city to run were puzzled.

The Friends of Historic Meridian (FHM), a nonprofit organization formed in 1974 to create and sustain an active appreciation of local history.

In 1987 Paul and Vi Allen sold their house to Meridian Township. The house was renovated into the nature center in 1996

1957

According to the Township records, Naomi Whitmyer becomes the **first** female elected to serve on the Meridian Township Board on February 16. 1953. She served as Treasurer until April 2, 1957 when she did not run for re-election again.



1969

LSJ reported, Meridian Mall opened on November 6, 1969 The cost to build the mall was \$18 million with more than 50 stores employing around 1,500 people. J.W. Knapp and Woolco anchored the mall when it opened.



1974 - 1986

The South Park was bought in 1974 by Ingham County after the amusement park shut down. Fire had gutted the "Casino" pavilion, which had initially been built by the trolley company during Spiritualist camp days. A historic Denzel carousel in the amusement park was sold to Cedar Point. In 1986, Lake Lansing Park North was completed.









In 2017, the Harris Nature Center (HNC) will celebrate its 20th Anniversary. As part of the 175th Anniversary Celebration, the Harris Nature Center Foundation will host a Turtle Toast Gala to highlight the nature center's history, celebrate its success and raise funds for the continuation of the Nature Exploration Area.

Since opening its doors in 1997, the HNC has steadily increased its visitorship to almost 20,000 each year. People come from the entire Greater Lansing area to walk the refreshing trails, play in the Nature Exploration Area and observe the many live animal exhibits. Each year the center presents approximately 450 programs, engaging people of all ages in nature experiences. 200 of these are school programs that allow over 4,400 students annually to enhance their academics with nature discoveries.

In 2010, the Foundation began raising funds for projects. In 2012, they started raising funds for the Nature Exploration Area. Currently the area includes a Climbable Turtle Sculpture, Log Jam, Michigan Fossil Dig, Sticks and Stones, Gathering Circle and Beaver Lodge. Foundation supporters also provided funds for the River Overlook and the School Bus Scholarship Project which allows 50 classes annually to participate in nature field trips that may have not been affordable otherwise. Future projects include finishing the Nature Exploration Area with 2 Tree Houses and a Sky Walk to connect them


